UDS Report

As you know we are required to file a UDS (Uniform Date Set) on the number of clients served, their characteristics, services, etc. We are in the process of collecting the data, but at this point we know that we served 31,269 in calendar year 2017. That is up from 28,895 in 2016. Submission must be done by February 15, 2018. It will not be complete by the Board meeting but we will get it to you next month.

Monthly Statistical Report:

Attached is the monthly visits statistics for the FQHC clinics and you will see that we were down over 500 visits for December. The number of providers off for the holiday period probably accounts for some of that. The Flu season is also impacting staff including providers.

<u>Children Health Services Extended Hours:</u>

During the first month so far, we have been seeing an average of 4 patients per night after scheduling 6-7 patients per evening. There is a 50% no show rate. Since this has just started, we need to be continue to improve the numbers and hopefully reduce the no show rate.

Manteca Clinic:

The Manteca has been seeing 500 to 700 people per month. Because the opportunity is there, we want to continue growing it. So we will try to generate some public information and awareness of the new site with the help of a PR firm.

HRSA Site Visit:

November 6, 7, & 8, 2018 is our HRSA site visit. It is usually a two full day and probably a half day for the last day. We will be preparing for that visit starting after the FQHC renewal is submitted in March. One of the issues we will need to address is a Strategic Plan. To complete it, we may want to plan to do some strategic planning during the summer to complete it by Fall. That might involve a day event or two half days depending on how we structure it.

Quality Committee:

The Board Chair suggested a Quality committee at the last Board meeting. It is really appropriate that the Board review the quality measurements of the services on an on-going basis. A two or three member committee could examine some of the data we use and make summary reports to the Board. It would typically be a quarterly report and should start with the measures we are required to report by HRSA like the UDS reports. The Clinics are also involved in PRIME measures which are working to improve the health of the entire community serviced by San Joaquin Hospital and the Clinics. From time to time there are other measures as well such as Patient Satisfaction Surveys.
